

At a regular reconvened meeting of the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors held on Thursday, September 19, 1991 at 2:00 p.m. convening at the lighthouse bridge, the following members were present: Mason A. Vaughan, Sr., Chairman; Jerry D. White, Vice-Chairman; Bruce L. Fariss; Joseph L. Sheffey; and V. E. Vaughn.

Also present were County Administrator Joseph N. Morgan, County Attorney Thomas J. McCarthy, Jr., and Commissioner of Revenue Maynard H. Sayers.

The Supervisors toured Claytor Lake downstream from Lowman's Ferry bridge and reviewed the following:

1. Boat house tax assessment;
2. Dock extensions beyond the zoning ordinance limits, either through non-conforming use or special use permits, on the property of Robert Edens and the Mallard Point development;
3. Clapboard Hollow no wake buoy request;
4. Harry's Point Road plat vacation proposal;
5. Texas Hollow no wake buoy request;
6. State Park area water and sewer extension;
7. Zoning changes to guide future development;
8. Public boat ramp locations;
9. Pressure sewage systems as an alternative for waste water disposal;
10. No wake request administration through a special use permit under the county zoning ordinance; and
11. Jet ski regulations.

It was the consensus that the staff should review these matters and provide additional information to the Supervisors.
