SUBJECT: Old Courthouse Reconstruction Change Order Exterior Wall Stabilization

Enclosed please find preliminary cost estimates on the wall stabilization.

Architect Douthat has engaged Richard Williams, structural engineer, to advise on the best remedy. Mr. Williams recommends the proposal by Concrete Reconstructors, Inc., which propose to spray on a gunite material over wire reinforcement. The cost to the general contractor for this work has been quoted at \$60,500. We anticipate having the details in both total costs and time from Avis Construction by Monday night's meeting.

The courthouses committee recommends proceeding as recommended by the architect and engineer.

There are also matters of legal concern regarding the old courthouse construction, which I recommend reviewing with the Board and county attorney in executive session on Monday evening.
