

At a reconvened meeting of the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors in the Town of Dublin and convened in the parking lot of Wade's Supermarket at noon on Tuesday, October 6, 1992, the following members were present: Jerry D. White, Chairman; Joseph L. Sheffey, Vice-Chairman; Ira S. "Pete" Crawford; and Mason A. Vaughan, Sr. Supervisor Bruce L. Fariss joined the meeting in route. Also present were: H. Ronald Coake, County Engineer; Peter M. Huber, Assistant County Administrator; Thomas J. McCarthy, Jr., County Attorney; and Joseph N. Morgan, County Administrator. The Board members and staff in attendance departed to review potential industrial sites.

RE: Executive Session

Once the full Board had come together, it was moved by Mr. Vaughan, seconded by Dr. Fariss and carried, that the Board enter executive session pursuant to Section 2.1-344(A) of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, for the purpose of discussing land acquisition and/or disposition.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pulaski County, Virginia, has convened an executive meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of The Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.1-344.1 of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this Board of Supervisors that such executive meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Pulaski County, Virginia, hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements by Virginia law were discussed in the executive meeting to which this certification resolution applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the executive meeting were heard, discussed or considered by the Board of Supervisors.
