

At a special called meeting of the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors held on Monday, March 19, 1993, in the Conference Room of New River Community College at 7:45 a.m., the following supervisors were present: Jerry D. White, Chairman; Bruce L. Fariss; and Joseph L. Sheffey. Supervisors Ira S. "Pete" Crawford and Mason A. Vaughan, Sr. were unable to attend the meeting.

The Chairman called the meeting to order.

It was moved by Mr. Sheffey, seconded by Dr. Fariss and carried, that the Board adopt the following declaration of emergency:

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Pulaski does hereby find:

1. That due to the heavy snowfall and windstorms, the County of Pulaski is facing dangerous conditions;
2. That due to the extreme weather, a condition of extreme peril to life and property necessitates the proclamation of the existence of an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that an emergency now exists throughout said county; and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the Director of Emergency Services and the Board of Supervisors of the County of Pulaski shall be those prescribed by State law and the ordinances, resolutions, and approved plans of the County of Pulaski in order to mitigate the effects of said emergency.

Voting yes: Dr. Fariss, Mr. Sheffey, Mr. White.

Voting no: none.

Absent: Mr. Vaughan, Mr. Crawford.

It was moved by Dr. Fariss, seconded by Mr. Sheffey and carried, that the meeting be adjourned. The next regular scheduled meeting will be held on Monday, March 22, 1993, at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 143 Third Street, N. W., in the Town of Pulaski, Virginia.
