

Tax Service Partnerships Commissioner of the Revenue Office

VITA Partnership (Change of Service)

The Commissioner of the Revenue's partnership with New River Community Action and their Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program was suspended starting in 2021 due to the coronavirus health crisis and the inability to provide sufficient staff and time needed to meet VITA's specific requirements.

Pulaski County residents may still access a local VITA representative from February through April by contacting Community Action directly at (540) 320-3217 or (540) 980-5525. VITA services provide free tax assistance for both Federal and State filing for those who qualify.

The Commissioner's office will continue to provide tax forms and assist in the preparation and filing of Virginia's individual income tax returns for our community members at no charge throughout the year.
