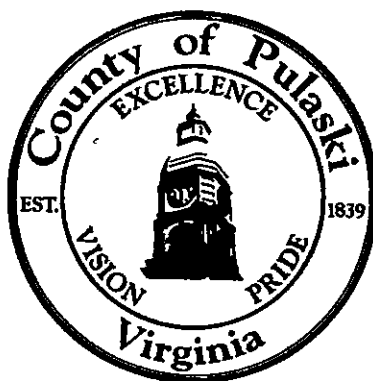

The Pulaski County Electoral Board met on September 28, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. in the Registrar's Office for the purpose of preparing for the November Presidential Election. Persons present were: Amy Lewis, Chair, Janet Johnson, Vice Chair, Sybil S. Atkinson, Secretary and Kathryn Webb, Registrar.

Amy Lewis, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Mrs. Webb presented information stating that we had ordered 100% of the voters numbers for each precinct. At this time, over 700 have already voted in the early voting process. She recommended we order an additional 2000 ballots for the CAP. Motion was made by Amy Lewis and seconded by Janet Johnson to order these additional ballots. The motion was unanimous.

List of 92 Election Officials was distributed and all have been sent letters concerning the Training date/place, Central Gym, October 10, at 9:00, 11:00 and 1:00.

Medical Reserve Corp will be sending masks for workers. We have requested assistance for just the Lions Club and Gym buildings.

Amy Lewis reported on our Emergency locations from our Security Plan. Pulaski County High School was recommended for the alternative rather than the New River Community College location. Motion was seconded by Sybil Atkinson and was unanimous. The Security Plan will be updated to reflect this change.

Drop Boxes for election day have been purchased for each building and chains and locks will be purchased for security.

COVID Supply Boxes will again be sent to each precinct.

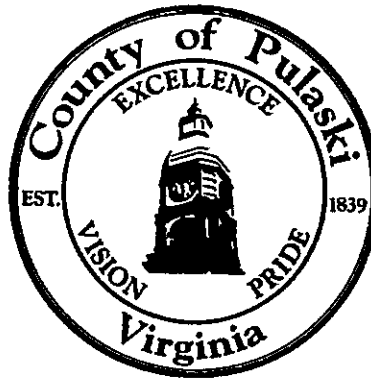
Pre-processing dates were scheduled, 5-8 p.m. on October 20, 22, 27, 29.

The Pulaski County Electoral Board met on September 9, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. in the Registrar's Office for the purpose of preparing for the November Presidential Election. Persons present were: Amy Lewis, Chair, Janet Johnson, Vice Chair, Sybil S. Atkinson, Secretary and Kathryn Webb, Registrar.

Amy Lewis, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:07 a.m.

Training location and dates were unanimously approved: Central Gym on Saturday, October 10. There will be three times to comply with COVID small gathering regulations: 9:00, 11:00, 1:00. We will train approximately 30 workers at a time, about 1½ hours each with ½ hour in between to clean tables, etc.

Amy Lewis will contact the Medical Reserve Corp and ask for assistance at just the Lions Club and Central Gym buildings. She will also decline their offer to help during our training sessions.

Amy Lewis will send out a letter to all of our "emergency locations" for our polling locations confirming that they are still available for our use on Election Day.

The CAP workers will be "employees" for preprocessing of ballots. This will not be COVID money. They will be paid \$40.00 per evening (1-4 evenings). The dates will be decided once we have a better idea of the number of ballots involved.

Precinct drop boxes were discussed and chains and locks will be purchased for their security on Election Day..

COVID supply boxes will be compiled once all items have arrived.

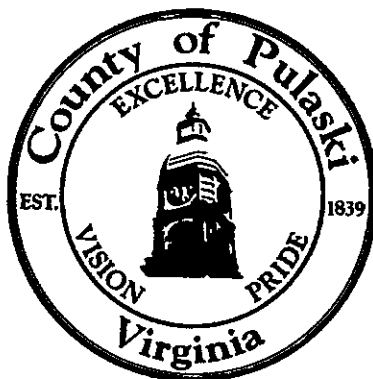
Our next Electoral Board meeting will be September 28 at 8:00 a.m.

The Pulaski County Electoral Board met on August 31, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. in the Registrar's Office for the purpose of preparing for the November Presidential Election. Persons present were: Amy Lewis, Chair, Janet Johnson, Vice Chair, Sybil S. Atkinson, Secretary and Kathryn Webb, Registrar.

Amy Lewis, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:04 a.m.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, we must cancel our usual meal and training held at the Lions Club in October. The Board decided to work toward holding the training on a Saturday in October (3, 10, 17). Sybil Atkinson will cancel the Lions Club and catering that had already been reserved. We will contact the County to see if the Central Gym is available.

The Medical Reserve Corp has offered assistance for the upcoming election. Amy Lewis will contact them to get more information.

The Registrar, Kathryn Webb, recommended that the CAP workers be our pre-processing "employees". We will get more information as to the possible use of COVID money for their work, which will be evenings 5-8 p.m. for 1-4 days.

The early voting location will be the first two weeks in the Registrar's office and then the month of October in the IT Training room.

Kathryn Webb showed us possible items that could be used for Drop Boxes. After seeing these proposed boxes, it was unanimously approved to order drop boxes for each building as well as the Registrar's Office.

It was decided to wait until all of the COVID supplies have arrived to set a date to put the COVID supply boxes together for the precincts.

Kathryn Webb showed us the new ID confirmation form.

Our next Electoral Board meeting will be September 9 at 8:00 a.m.

The meeting adjourned at 9:05 a.m.
