Veteran's Christmas Trees Viewing & Open House Pulaski County Old Historic Courthouse December 9, 2017 – 1 p.m.

The Pulaski County Courthouses Exhibits Committee and the Pulaski County World War I & World War II Commemoration Committee will hold an open house at the Pulaski County Old Historic Courthouse on Saturday, December 9, 2017 from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. At this time the public is invited to view the Veteran's Christmas Trees decorated with over 250 military photographs of Pulaski County veterans and members of the armed forces. Further, the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) will be presenting commemorative pins/certificate to county Vietnam Veterans who have not previously received these pins/certificates. Those who do not contact Carol Smith prior to the above deadline will receive a commemorative pin and the certificate will be mailed at a later date.
