GENERAL DEFINITION OF WORK:

Perform professional work relating to the maintenance and mowing of properties owned and operated by the County of Pulaski and School Board. Work jointly with existing school board grounds personnel on the performance of duties. Work is performed under the supervision of designated County of Pulaski and School Board personnel.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform mowing/maintenance duties that enhance the appearance of assigned properties
- Warm months require concentration on keeping all properties mowed on a daily basis. Cold months require performing special projects/duties as assigned in the upkeep of all properties.
- Perform duties that provide for a safe outside environment for general public
- Complete county or school division's ground routine maintenance as directed by Supervisor
- Remain mindful of the professional appearance of grounds at all times
- Modify, repair, and maintain all equipment associated with job at all times
- Set up for special events as well as assist in manual labor countywide projects as needed
- To be conscientious of team work to benefit the overall county and school division
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High School diploma or GED equivalency is required. Previous experience in the operation of mowing and grounds equipment is desired.

ABILITIES/SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have the ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds to a maximum of 150 pounds
- Ability to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions
- Ability to stoop, bend, work in bent positions for short time
- Ability to operate a variety of machines included but not limited to, riding lawn mowers, edgers, weed eaters, and push mowers
- Ability to complete tasks in a timely manner
- Possession of a valid appropriate drivers permit issued by the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- Must pass a post-offer criminal background check and drug screen tests
- May be required to obtain Virginia Commercial Drivers License (CDL) with Class A endorsement
