Open for qualified voters to vote by absentee ballot.  
**November 5th** is the last day qualified voters can  
vote by absentee ballot in person.

**Note:** The last day qualified voters can apply for an absentee ballot by mail is **Tuesday, November 1, 2016.**

The Constitution of Virginia requires that in order to be qualified to register to vote in the November 8, 2016 Election you must be a citizen of the United States, be eighteen years of age on or before the next General Election, have domicile and a place of abode in Pulaski County and that you be registered in the precinct in which you reside.

All requests for reasonable accommodations due to a disability should be made to the Registrar with at least a 48 hour notice.

**PHOTO Identification Will be Required When You Vote November 8, 2016.** Acceptable forms of PHOTO ID are: valid VA Driver's License, DMV-issued Photo ID card, Government Photo ID, valid Employee Photo ID Card, valid US Passport, valid College or University Student Photo ID or a Virginia Voter Photo ID Card. Check with the Voter Registration Office if you have questions regarding this. **If you do not have an acceptable form of Photo ID, please contact the Pulaski County Registrar's Office for a free Virginia Voter Photo Identification Card.**
