



## WHAT TO RECYCLE AND WHAT NOT TO RECYCLE

### Mixed Paper

**White Paper** - This includes white printer paper, white copy paper, white notebook paper, and white envelopes - with or without windows.

**Newspaper** - includes the actual newspaper and any advertisements inside the paper. Please remove any plastic bags.

Envelope samples and other items that may come in the paper are not acceptable to recycle with newspaper.

**Phone Books** - may now be placed in with newspapers to be recycled.

**Magazines & Catalogs** - This includes all magazines and catalogs.

### Acceptable Items

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Paper Grocery Bags
- Paper Tube Cores (from paper towels & toilet paper)
- Phone Books
- Small Cardboard Boxes (flattened, non waxed, remove all plastic & Styrofoam materials from boxes)
- Note pads / Index cards
- Writing Paper
- Computer Paper
- Envelopes Any Color (with or without cellophane windows)
- Manila Folders
- Junk Mail
- Brochures & Circulars
- Paperboard boxes: Cereal Boxes (no liners), Shoe Boxes, Tissue Boxes
- Construction Paper
- Wrapping Paper (brown & Christmas wrapping)

## Not Acceptable Items

- Paper Towels
- Paper Plates & Cups
- Plastic Reinforced Folders
- Kleenex® & Bathroom Tissue
- Waxed Paper
- Cellophane / Plastic Wrap
- Aluminum / Tin Foil
- Foam Rubber
- Food To Go Boxes
- Styrofoam Food Boxes
- Cereal Box Liners
- Any Food Boxes With Direct Contact to Food Residue
- No Plastic Bags
- No Plastic Film Wraps
- Packaging Materials: Styrofoam, Peanuts, Bubble Wrap, (any plastic or Styrofoam packaging materials)
- Metal & Plastic Spiral Bindings
- Carbon Paper
- Hard Back Books
- Tyvek® Material Overnight Envelopes

**\* MIXED PAPER MUST BE UNSPOILED AND NOT CONTAMINATED WITH FOOD RESIDUE & GREASE. REMOVE ANY PLASTIC FILM, BAGS FROM PAPER. NO STYROFOAM**

## Glass, Plastic, Metal, and Aluminum

### Commingled Containers: Recycling Glass, Plastic, Metal & Aluminum

Before recycling Commingled Containers, they should have lids removed. Labels do not need to be removed.

- All aluminum beverage containers (ABCs)
- Aluminum foil and disposable aluminum foil pans (frozen food trays, pie shell pans, etc.)
- Steel cans (soup, beans, pet food, etc.) including tops and bottoms



- Steel lids from glass jars and bottles
- All colors of glass bottles and jars
- Plastic **Bottles and Jugs only**, #1 and #2 only

### Not Acceptable

- Cat litter buckets
- Glass besides food or beverage containers
- Glassware, crystal, ceramics, plate glass, mirrors
