

Pulaski County Small Business Recovery Grant Program

Our small businesses are essential to Pulaski County, and we are here to assist you with navigating these difficult times. The Pulaski County Board of Supervisors has made available grants to support our small business community and help with your recovery efforts.

Financial assistance for small businesses in Pulaski County impacted by COVID-19 will be made available on August 3, 2020. Pulaski County Small Business Recovery Grants in the amount of up to \$5,000.00 grants can be used for <u>critical</u> operating expenses to offset some of the impacts of the shutdown and aid in responding to COVID-19. Critical expenses include but are not limited to payroll, operating and reopening expenses.

Eligibility

- Businesses that are based in Pulaski County, Virginia (Both community and home-based businesses)
- Pulaski County businesses that were in operation prior to February 15, 2020
- Pulaski County businesses with 25 or less employees across all locations
- Pulaski County businesses that have not already been granted Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) funds will get first priority; however, all businesses that meet requirements are eligible
- Pulaski County businesses that are registered and in good standing with the State Corporation Commission (SCC) (as applicable)
- Pulaski County businesses that have a business EIN or file a Schedule C, E or F Tax Form
- Pulaski County businesses that are up to date on all Pulaski County taxes, charges and fees
- Pulaski County businesses that have a Pulaski County Business License prior to July 15, 2020 (as applicable)

How to Apply

The County of Pulaski will administer the program. Forms can be downloaded from the Pulaski County website at: <u>www.pulaskicounty.org</u>. Applications will be accepted on a first come first served basis starting on August 3, 2020 for businesses that have not received Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) funds. All other eligible businesses can apply starting August 10, 2020.

<u>NOTE</u>: The entirety of the Pulaski County Small Business Recovery Grant Program is funded at a level of \$300,000.00 through a CARES Act appropriation to Pulaski County, Virginia. The program will conclude on December 1, 2020 <u>or</u> at which time the funds for the program have been depleted.
